

### 1) Academic:

#### a) Teaching Methodology;

To provide stimuli to the intellect of the child to learn and develop a love for learning. Most modern methods of teaching are practiced. Use of power point presentation, audio- visual teaching aids, Projectors are emphasized to a large extent in order to make teaching learning process interesting and effective.

#### b) Library:

An open access to a well stocked spacious library caters to the needs of students and provides them opportunity to supplement their curriculum requirements in various subjects. Library consists of about 2000 books including reference books, encyclopedia, novels and periodicals which nourish the child's craving for learning. Students are encouraged to spend most of their spare time in the library to enrich their knowledge.

#### c) Labs:

Well equipped,ultra modern physics, Chemistry and Biology labs are there for young scientists to confirm their theoretical ideas by performing experiments

#### d) Computer lab:

**Hygiene:**School provides safe, potable drinking water, hand washing facilities and clean, safe toilets.




#### 3) Events:

- a) Fairs and Exhibitions: School organizes science exhibition every year so that students may get a chance to apply or do the practical aspect of the things that they have learned from the classroom.
- b) Trips And Tours: Educational trips are a major educational element and Students of all ages enjoy and benefit from outings, visits. Taking this into consideration we organize at least one trip annually for classes 3<sup>rd</sup> onwards so that they may experience new environments and enjoy a day away from the classroom.
- c) Celebrations: As a part of our efforts to inculcate in students the appreciation of and respect for India's rich heritage and diversity and also to reinforce in them national pride and respect for all, the school celebrates a number of functions including Diwali, Holi, Dussehra, RakshaBandhan, Teacher's Day, Children's day, Independence Day, Mother's Day, Grandparent's Day.
- d) Sports: "Sports do not build character, they reveal it" This is truly said by someone.HimGurukul understands that and provides its students with various indoor and outdoor games. Training is provided in various games and sports to prepare students for interschool, State and National level competitions. The school offers sports followingfacilities:badminton,Football,volleyb

all, judo and karate, chess, carom etc.





- 4) Assembly: The morning assembly starts with "Gayatri Mantra" followed by prayer and then National song. The students of House On duty present "Thought Of the Day", news. Training of public speaking and GK quiz are the regular features of the assembly. The assembly is concluded by National Anthem everyday. Two teachers in a weekfrom The house on duty share their views in assembly(Teacher's talk).
- 5) Student Council: For increasing scope for the pupils to develop their social skills, a house system has been developed for student from class 4th to 11th.Students are divided into

fourhouses named:1)Mars2)Mercury 3) Venus 4) Jupiter.A house master and a

group of mentors look after each house. Interhouse competitions are organized on Saturday after lunch break.

Interhouse competitions includes competitions, Debate, declamation, rangoli making competitions, making competitions, mehendi competitions, making competitions etc.Overall champion house of above competitions is appreciated and rewarded with a beautiful trophy.

**6)Discipline:** Him Gurukul International School believes in discipline with firmness. Disobedience and disregard of rules are not tolerated. Any breach of common sense or of good manners or any action or a word, likely to lower the good name of school, is regarded as a breach of school discipline. The school reserves the right to expel students whose diligence or progress in studies is consistently unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to others. Immorality, grave insubordination, theft, fraud, damage or loss of school's property, giving false information, threating, abusing or assaulting any school employee or student are always sufficient reasons for immediate expulsion.



7) Examination System: We believe, testing students on the basis of crammed answers of previous exercises or the retention power is of no use, until and unless scholars are aware of practical use of the concept learnt. Examination system at Him Gurukul strongly encourages THINKING not CRAMMING, where practical understanding of the concepts and thinking skills are tested. Practical knowledge cannot be gained just with pen and paper test. Besides written test, monthly assessment activities are an integral part of the examination system where student's knowledge about practical implementation of the concepts is tested. Examination system at HGIS is as follows:

 Assessment: Students are assessed as per the direction of CBSE.



#### 8) School rules:

#### a) Absent and leave:

- 1) No leave of absence is granted except on prior written application from parents or guardians for a valid reason only.
- 2) Only one leave is allowed in a month.
- 3) Without leave student has to pay fine.
- 4)Parents are requested to send a leave application if the child has to be absent for more than one day.
- 5) It is mandatory for parents to come to school whenever they get a call from school.
- 6) Student will be rusticated for one week for any misbehave with any one in school campus or school bus.
- 7) The name will be stuck off if he or she found guilty of misbehave for the second time.
- 8) A student returning to school after an infection or contagious disease should get a fitness certificate from the doctor.
- 9)A student suffering from such contagious disease must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.
- 10)Minimum 80% attendance is compulsory to appear in the annual exam.

#### **b) Promotion Rules:**

- 1) Promotion to the next class is granted to the pupil on the basis of his/her overall performance during the academic session.
- 2) A child has to score 40% marks in the grand total of each subject to get promotion in the next class. No Re-test supplementary exam is conducted.

#### c) Withdrawal:

1) A clear calendar months' notice in written must be given before the withdrawal of the pupil.

### 9)School Timing:

- 1)Nursery to Third-9 AM to 2:15 PM
- 2) Grade third onwards-9 AM to 3 PM

**10)School Uniform:** Him Gurukul International School Prescribes uniform for all students. Students are expected to take pride in their personal appearance and to conform to all rules governing the school uniform. The details of the uniform is as follows:

#### a) Days: Monday, Wednesday and Friday:

- 1) For Boys: White shirt with checkered collar and cuffs and pocket on left, mixed black trouser with two pockets on sides, school tie (to be worn in winters only) and belt, white socks, black socks.
- 2) **For Girls:** White shirt with checkered collar and cuffs and pocket on left, Checkered skirt, school tie and belt, white rubber band, white socks and black shoes.





## b) On Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday:

- 1) For Boys: Checkered shirt, mixed blue trouser, school tie and belt, grey socks and black shoes.
- 2) For Girls: Checkered shirt, mixed grey skirt, school tie and belt, black rubber band, grey socks and black shoes.
- c) In winters: Navy blue pullover, navy blue blazer with metal buttons and school crest.
- **d**) Blazer is compulsory from 3<sup>rd</sup> onwards. Pre-primary students are supposed to wear checkered hood over pullover.
- **e**)On activity day (Saturday) it is compulsory for students 1<sup>st</sup> onward to wear t-shirts representing their houses.

#### NOTE: Students should have plain haircut. Girls having long hair should make plaits.
